This access statement does not contain personal opinions as to our suitability for those with access needs, but aims to describe the facilities and services available to our visitors.



## **Parking**

**Car Parks:** Parking is free in all District Council car parks for blue-badge holders and if the designated parking bays are full you may park in any other parking bay. Other car parks may charge.

**On-street:** This is free for blue-badge holders for as long as required unless there is a traffic sign specifying a time limit or the bay is marked for a specific use only, for example taxi rank.

**Stratford Park & Ride** is situated at Bishopton, CV37 9QY.



The Guild Chapel is free to enter. Donations towards its maintenance and upkeep are appreciated.

### **Opening Times:**

The Guild Chapel is open to the public all year round from 10am to 4.00pm. It is manned by volunteers Monday to Saturday but this may fluctuate depending on resources available.

**Access:** The pavements are uneven around the entrance. There is a 125mm (5") step into the Guild Chapel and 2 ramps are kept inside the Porch for use by wheelchair and mobility scooter users, as they take you across the pavement too. The weight capacity for the ramps is TBC. The Guild Chapel is level throughout.



Ramps can either be requested from Guild Chapel volunteers upon arrival or by telephone in advance. If you require ramped access and wish to ensure it is available for your visit then please contact us on 01789 207 111.

**Quiet Areas:** We understand there are times when you or someone you are with may need a break from the hustle and bustle of other visitors. The Chancel is preserved as a quiet area.

Visiting first thing in the morning or later in the afternoon is often quieter. Please contact us if you would like to discuss your visit so that we can understand your needs and expectations and help you get the most out of your visit.

**Assistance Dogs** are welcome.



### **Hearing:**

An induction loop is in operation during services.



### **Accessible Toilet:**

There are no toilets or baby-change facilities at the Guild Chapel.

Public accessible toilets and baby-change facilities (which require a radar key) are located on Waterside (adjacent Carluccio's restaurant) and the Theatre Gardens, close to Holy Trinity Church.



The nearest Changing Places toilet is situated at Stratford Leisure Centre, CV37 6YX.

The Falcon Hotel opposite the Guild Chapel has an Accessible WC available to customers.
