There are 3 skulls – 2 in the Allegory painting and 1 stone carving (on nave window).

QUESTION 2:

On the nave floor, in Allegory painting and in the Dance of Death.

QUESTION 3:

There are 21 shields in the Chapel.

QUESTION 4:

On the south wall of the nave, part of the Life of Adam painting which has been uncovered. We believe it is some kind of musical instrument.

QUESTION 5:

John Shakespeare is shown in the stained-glass window

QUESTION 6:

We think there are 32 different kinds of flowers in total.

The Doom.

QUESTION 11:

Above the door into the Nave from the Porch

QUESTION 12:

George & the Dragon can be seen on the upper west wall – north side.

Archangel Michael can be found in the Allegory.
